

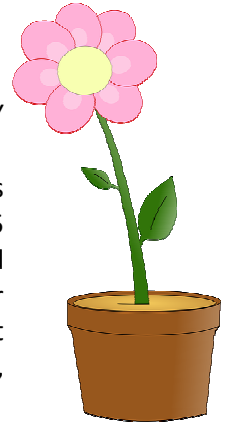

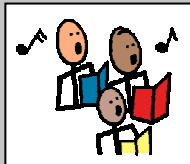
## Joan's Plant Sale 2018

Since 2009 the Plant Sale has raised £21, 555 for Macmillan Support. Joan has been given a covered trolley made by Dave Hayselden so that tender plants can be put out earlier in the season. This year Joan is asking for any donations of plants, seedlings and cuttings, as the local DIY store has changed their policy on plant donations.

The money raised from the Plant Sale funds the Cancer Self-Help and Social Group, which meets on the last Friday of the month (except Bank Holidays) at The Oddfellows Meeting Rooms, 175 Boothferry Road, Goole from 12 noon to 2pm. Light Refreshments are served, which are provided by Joan and the meetings are free of charge due to Joan's Fund Raising. The Group is primarily for those who have had a cancer diagnosis, are currently receiving treatment or are in remission, but friends and family are most welcome to accompany them. The aim of the Group is to offer help, support and friendship to anyone who has been affected by cancer.

### Services at St. David's during April

**1<sup>st</sup> April** Easter Sunday service at 10-00 am. All ages welcome

**Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> April** Holy Communion 10-00am

**Sunday, 15<sup>th</sup> April** Shortened service of Holy Communion 6-00 pm

This will be followed by the **Annual Vestry Meeting** for the election of the two Airmyn churchwardens for the coming year and then by the **Annual General Meeting of the Parochial Church Council**. Members of the public are welcome to attend these two meetings which will commence at approximately 6-40 pm and last for about an hour.

Reports on the past year will be presented by the Vicar, the PCC Secretary, the PCC Treasurer and the churchwardens.

**Sunday, 22<sup>nd</sup> April** Family service 10-00 am

**Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> April** Benefice service at St. Mary's church, Hook, for the people of Hook, Airmyn and Rawcliffe all together 10-00 am.

Everyone is reminded that you do not need to have been confirmed or to take communion in order to attend a service of Holy Communion. All these services include appropriate, often seasonal, hymns and prayers as well as a talk from whoever is leading the service.

### The Electoral Roll

The church's electoral roll will be revised and updated at the above-mentioned Annual General Meeting of the PCC. Anyone wishing to have their name added to this electoral roll should contact David Galloway, preferably in advance of the meeting. It would enable you to have a vote on any Airmyn church matters which may arise in the future. A minimum requirement for being included on the church electoral roll is that you are baptised.

This electoral roll should not be confused with the Register of Electors, which is a totally separate document unconnected with the church and is a list of those who are entitled to vote at parliamentary elections or local government elections.
